

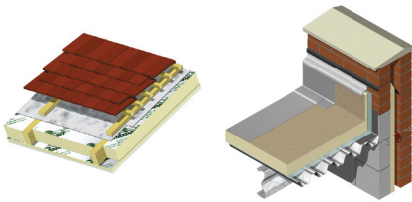

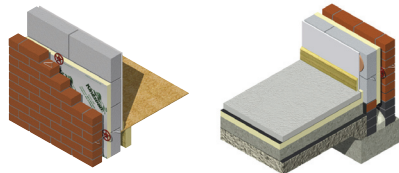


PITCHED ROOFING

Systems include insulating sarking, or combinations of insulation boards fitted between and under rafters. Systems are suitable for new build and conversion work, and for both domestic and commercial properties.

FLAT ROOFING

There are many systems available to suit particular applications including boards for built up systems, single-ply systems, mastic asphalt and insulated decking.



WALLS

Insulation systems can be used in most types of masonry and prefabricated frame panel wall systems. Conventional cavity wall, timber frame, steel stud frame systems and solutions for refurbishment of existing walls are all available.

FLOORS

Floor insulation boards offer particular flexibility for the complex requirements of the 2002 edition of Approved Document L. Solutions for timber and beam-and-block suspended floors are provided, in addition to over site slab floors.

ACOUSTIC PROTECTION

Noise pollution is becoming very problematic, the Government's new legislation changes to Approved Document Part E "Resistance to the Passage of Sound"- is now radically influencing the way the building industry approaches noise control, with new, improved sound reduction levels becoming mandatory for both new build and existing buildings. The Government is tackling the problem by introducing more robust building standards to improve soundproofing in new homes, residential dwellings and schools, for both new build and refurbishment projects.

FIRE PROTECTION

Buildings should be constructed in such a manner that if a fire starts, the extent of fire and smoke damage will be minimised and kept as close to the source of fire outbreak as is practical. The government has published 'goal based' functional requirements in Building Regulations that are supported by Approved Documents.
